Dear Parents / Carers

Classes 3 and 4 will be visiting Cusworth Hall Museum on **Tuesday 20th March** as part of their topic work on Victorians and how we used to live.

During their visit there will be a hands-on workshop, looking at Victorian artefacts and toys, where the children will find out what life was like in Victorian times and how different it was being a child in those times compared to today. The children will discover what jobs Victorian servants had to do, investigate household objects from the past and experience working in a kitchen, including washing with dolly tubs. They will also find out what it was like to go to a Victorian school to learn the 3 'R's (reading, reciting and reckoning).

In order to capture the spirit of the day, we would be delighted if the children could wear a basic Victorian costume for the visit, for example, long black skirts, pinafores, aprons, white shirts, waistcoats, black/grey trousers, mop caps, flat caps etc but please do not feel obliged to buy a costume; make use of clothes you already have or can borrow. Here are some examples:



The coach will depart immediately after registration and return to school in time for collection at 3:15pm.

Your child will require a packed lunch for this visit. Due to universal free school meals now being available for all infant school children, we are able to provide a packed lunch from school.
