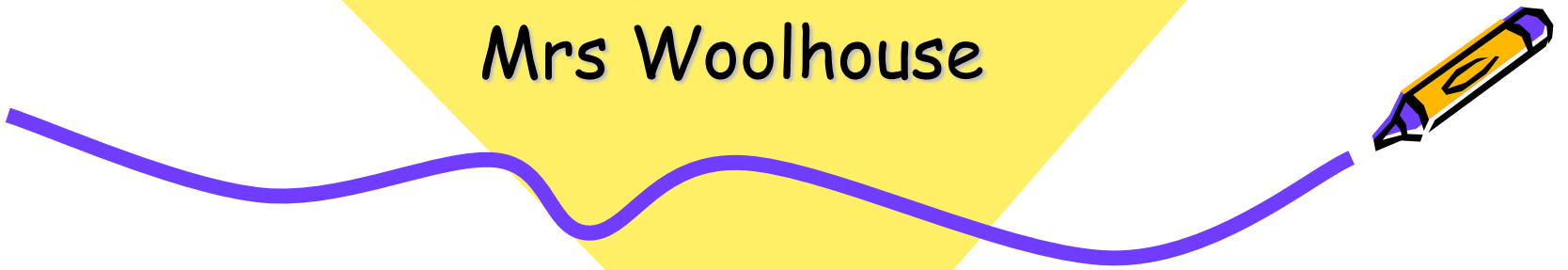


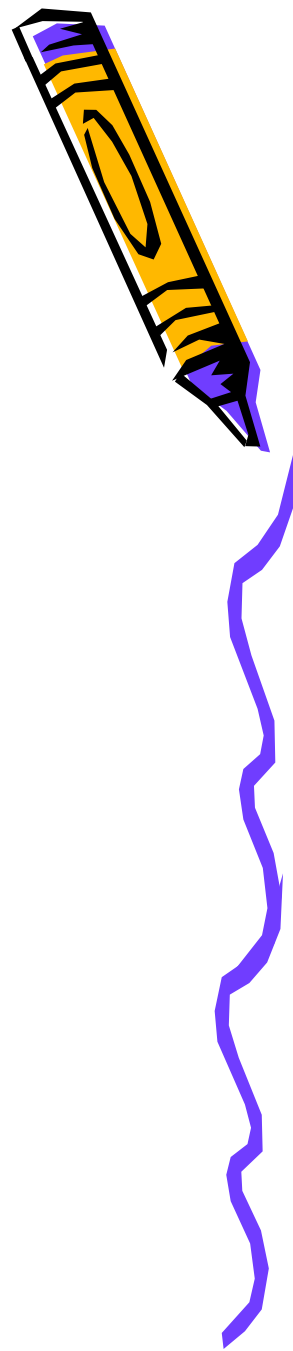

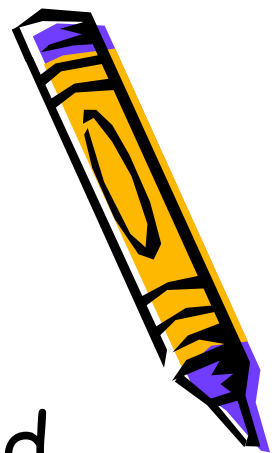

- Registration to start at 9am

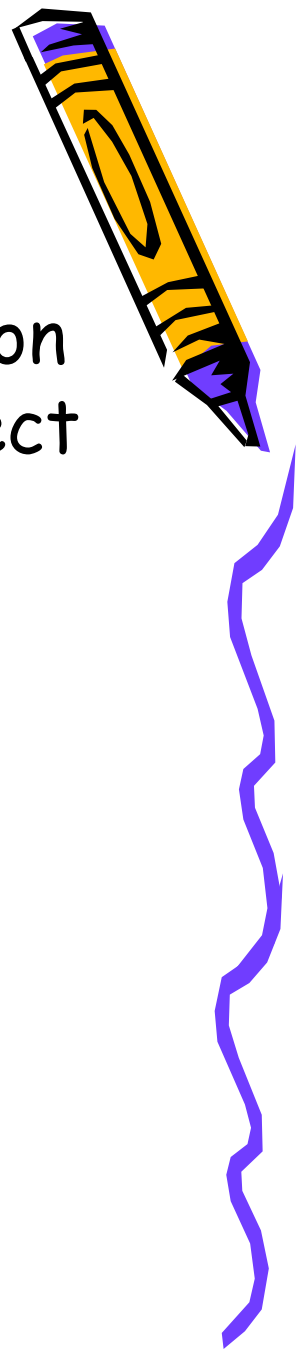


# Parental Involvement

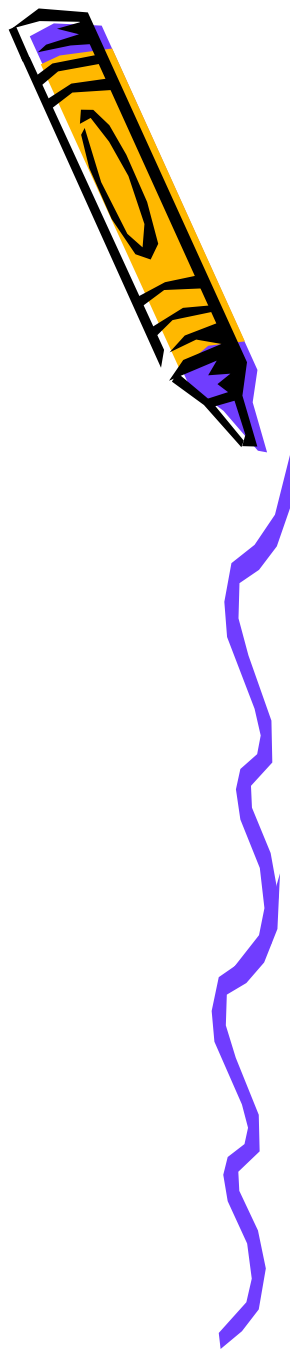

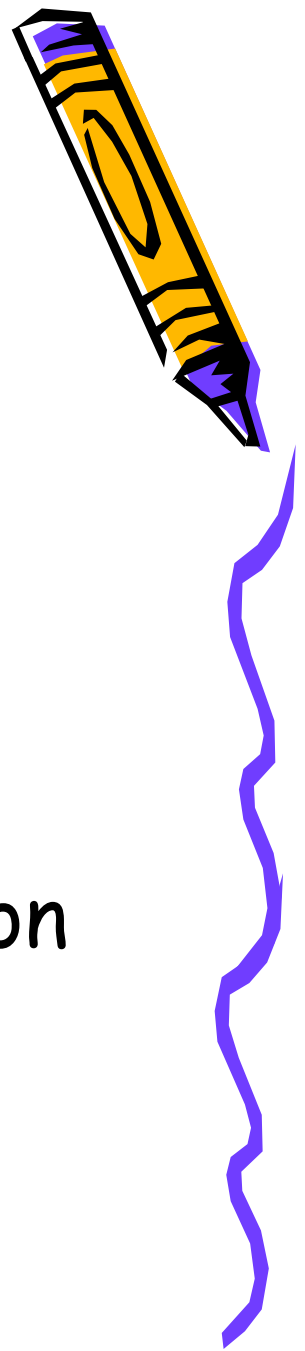

- Links to Literacy and Communication and Language



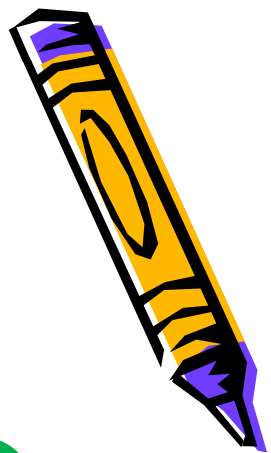
# Website



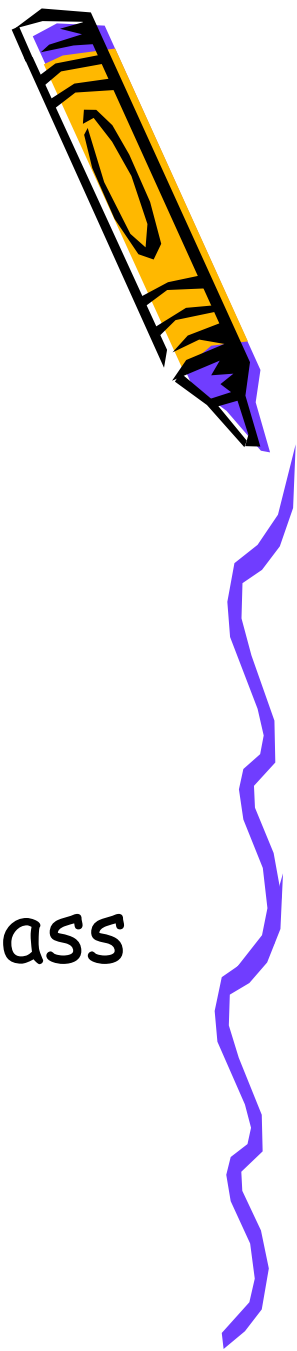
- We have a new school website. During the course of each half term we will update the blog to share some of the exciting things we do in class with you.
