School Kitchen Refurbishment

As you may have noticed, work has started on the refurbishment of our school kitchen this morning. This work should last approximately 7 weeks and should be completed during the October half term so we should be up and running with our brand new kitchen when we return in November.

We have been fortunate enough to obtain a grant to carry out this work so we have not had to fund this from our school budget. Ideally we would have preferred this work to have been carried out in the school holidays but due to timescales and work already pre-planned at other schools, this has been beyond our control.

We would like to reassure parents/carers that whilst this work is being carried out ALL school lunches (hot and cold) will not be affected as these are being prepared by our kitchen staff at the Junior School and being transported to our school ready for lunchtime.

Please do take extra caution on the road outside of school where there will be works vehicles leaving and entering our premises through our car park gates. Also because our car park is now out of bounds for our staff and visitors, there may be more cars parked outside of school. Staff are doing their best to keep this to a minimum by parking further away and walking to school and/or car sharing. Whilst we know this is difficult for parents/carers who may be continuing their journey to work etc, if you are able to assist us by doing this too, it would be a big help.

The security of our site will remain in place with the gates being closed at all times except when vehicles are leaving and entering the premises. All the building contractors involved also have the appropriate checks in place.
